**SUBJECT: Consider a Report from the Transportation and Public Works Committee Regarding the Possible Modification of the Tierra Rejada Road/Miller Parkway/Moorpark Road Intersection to Allow Through North-South Traffic**

**BACKGROUND**

In March 2008 the City Council approved the modification of the Moorpark Road/Tierra Rejada Road intersection to include dual left-turn lanes for northbound Moorpark Road traffic turning onto westbound Tierra Rejada Road. It is anticipated that construction of the dual left-turns will be completed by late summer of this year.

At that meeting the City Council also discussed the possibility of opening Miller Parkway/Moorpark Road to through traffic. The City Council directed staff to take this matter to the Transportation and Public Works Committee (Councilmembers Millhouse and Van Dam) for discussion and recommendation.

**DISCUSSION**

At the regular meeting of the Transportation and Public Works Committee held on April 7, 2008, the Committee discussed the design and function of the Miller Parkway/Moorpark Road/Tierra Rejada Road intersection. This intersection was designed and constructed to prohibit through north-south traffic from-to Miller Parkway & Moorpark Road. The Committee discussed the function of that intersection over the years since its construction, and the pros and cons of a project which would modify the intersection to allow through north-south traffic. After due consideration, the Committee recommended that the City Council take no action to implement such intersection modifications.

In addition, the City has received nine e-mails from the Serenata residents regarding this matter. Copies of those e-mails have been previously provided to the City Council.
