SUBJECT: Consider Amendment No. 2 to Agreement for Dial-A-Ride Paratransit Services with MV Transportation, Inc., Extending Agreement for Six Months with Rate Increases

SUMMARY

The first one-year Agreement extension for Dial-A-Ride Paratransit Services with MV Transportation Inc. (MV), expires June 30, 2008. The City has one more, one-year extension available. MV has requested that its Agreement only be extended for six months. Sufficient funds are proposed in the draft FY 2008/09 Paratransit budget request to pay for the extension and a rate increase.

DISCUSSION

In 2004, the City solicited proposals to operate and manage Dial-A-Ride Paratransit services of the City of Moorpark. The program consists of curb-to-curb demand responsive transportation for senior (aged 62+) citizens and persons with disabilities certified in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). MV Transportation Inc. (MV), was the successful proposer and received a three-year Agreement with two, one-year extensions. MV is paid a set fee for each trip it provides, as well as for each mile the vehicles travel during service. The system operates 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, to compliment the City's fixed-transit system. The current cost of service for operations is \$1.89 per trip and \$2.52 per mile.

MV has requested an increase to \$2.03 per trip (7.4 percent increase) and \$2.70 per mile (7.1 percent increase) for the next fiscal year. MV has also requested that this pricing only be valid until December 31, 2008. The date corresponds with the end of MV's contract with the City of Thousand Oaks, which is a much larger service area for MV than Moorpark. Staff proposes that the City also solicit proposals to operate and manage Dial-A-Ride Paratransit services at the same time as the City of Thousand Oaks.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

AGREEMENT FOR PROVIDING DIAL-A-RIDE PARATRANSIT SERVICES

THIS AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2008, by and between the City of Moorpark, a municipal corporation located in the County of Ventura, State of California, hereinafter referred to as "City" and MV Transportation, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Whereas, on July 9, 2004, the City and Contractor entered into an Agreement for providing Dial-A-Ride Paratransit Services, hereto referred to as Agreement, pertaining to all things necessary to operate and manage Dial-A-Ride Paratransit services of the City of Moorpark; and,

Whereas, the City has an exclusive option to extend the Agreement for one (1) one-year period; and,

Whereas, the City and Contractor have agreed to a six-month extension instead of the one-year period, and now wish to document said Agreement by jointly approving this Amendment No. 2 to the July 9, 2004 Agreement by amending the term and compensation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, benefits and premises herein stated, the parties hereto agree to amend the aforesaid Agreement and Amendments as follows:

I. Term of Agreement

Section 1, Term of Agreement, is hereby amended to extend the Agreement for providing Dial-A-Ride Paratransit Services to December 31, 2008, unless sooner terminated as provided in the Agreement.

II. Compensation

Section 3, Compensation, is hereby amended to reflect an adjustment to the per-trip amount from \$1.89 per trip to \$2.03 per trip effective July 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008. The Compensation is also hereby amended to reflect an adjustment to the per-mile amount from \$2.52 per mile to \$2.70 per mile effective July 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.

III. Remaining Provisions

All other provisions of the aforesaid Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
