**SUBJECT:** Consider Rescinding Prior Council Decision to Cancel Regular Meeting of August 16, 2006, and Consider Cancellation of the September 6, 2006, Regular Meeting

**BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

Staff is requesting the City Council reconsider their decision of May 3, 2006, to cancel the regular meeting of August 16, 2006, in order to accommodate the need to hold a continued open public hearing on Commercial Planned Development No. 2005-06 to allow construction of a retail home improvement warehouse Home Depot store and garden center located at the east end of Patriot Drive adjacent to State Route 23 Freeway and allow the anticipated adoption of at least two ordinances scheduled for introduction on August 2.

The Council may also want to consider cancellation of the September 6, 2006, regular meeting, since it conflicts with the annual conference for the League of California Cities. By canceling the September 6 meeting it would provide the same four week break between Council meetings as was previously scheduled.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Direct staff to post a notice rescinding the cancellation of August 16, 2006, regular meeting and to post a notice of meeting cancellation for September 6, 2006.
