SUBJECT: Consider Voting Delegate and Alternates for League of California Cities Annual Conference – September 18-20 in Sacramento

DISCUSSION

The League of California Cities (League) has provided the City with instructions for Council to designate a voting delegate and up to two alternate voting delegates in order to vote at the 2013 Annual Conference Business Meeting. The Conference will be held September 18th-20th at the Sacramento Convention Center.

Only individuals who have registered for the conference may be designated as voting delegates. The League procedures require the City Council to designate the voting delegate and up to two alternates.

At the present time, Mayor ProTem Van Dam and Councilmember Pollock will be attending the conference. Mayor Parvin is not planning to attend; therefore, Mayor ProTem Van Dam would be the voting delegate.

Any other attending Councilmember, the City Manager, or Assistant City Manager may be designated as voting delegate alternates.

FISCAL IMPACT

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

- 1) Designate Mayor ProTem Van Dam as the voting delegate and Councilmember Pollock and staff attending the conference as alternate voting delegates; and
- 2) Direct the City Clerk to notify the League of California Cities of the designated voting delegate and alternates.
