**SUBJECT:** Consider Rescinding Resolution No. 2002-1982 (Parking In-Lieu Fees)

**DISCUSSION**

City Council adopted Resolution No. 2007-2613 on July 18, 2007, establishing a new parking in-lieu fee for in the Downtown Specific Plan area, specifically the Old Town Commercial (C-OT) Zone as authorized by Ordinance No. 353 which amended the City's Parking Requirements. When the new parking in-lieu fee was established, Resolution No. 2002-1982 which previously set the parking in-lieu fee in the entire Downtown Specific Plan area was not rescinded. The attached resolution would rescind the previous Parking In-Lieu fee set in 2002.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORPARK, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2002-1982

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2007-2613, revising and updating the parking in-lieu fee for the Downtown Specific Plan area, specifically the Old Town Commercial (C-OT) zone, consistent with the requirements outlined in Chapter 17.32 of the Moorpark Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, since the parking in-lieu fee previously established by City Council Resolution No. 2002-1982 has been updated, leaving Resolution No. 2002-1982 in effect would cause confusion in the implementation of the parking in-lieu fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOORPARK DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Resolution No. 2002-1982 is hereby rescinded in its entirety and is no longer in effect.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause a certified resolution to be filed in the book of original Resolutions.
