SUBJECT: Consider Authorizing the Use of City Marquee Signs and Portable Lights for Rotary Club Civil War Reenactment Event

DISCUSSION

For the past few years, the Council approved the use of the City's portable lights and the City's marquee sign for the annual Civil War Reenactment event that is held by the Rotary Club of Moorpark. The Rotary Club of Moorpark is requesting the same for this year's event. Staff supports approval of the Rotary's 2007 event request, subject to the following conditions:

- Rotary will provide standard insurance and waiver of liability requirements for use of the marquee signs and portable lights as approved by the City's Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Director;
- City staff will deliver portable lights to the event site on November 9, with Rotary to be responsible for providing secure storage of the City's lights from the time of delivery until pickup;
- Rotary will be permitted use of no less than two City marquee signs; to include the name, date, time, and location of the Civil War Reenactment event for a maximum of two weeks.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Approve use of City marquee signs and approve use of City portable lights, subject to conditions specified in the agenda report.
