A Special Joint Meeting of the Moorpark City Council and Parks & Recreation Commission was held on May 23, 2007, at 6:00 p.m. at the Moorpark Community Center located at 799 Moorpark Avenue, Moorpark, California.

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Mr. Kueny gave the staff report.


In response to Mayor Hunter, Ms. Traffenstedt stated there were no speakers.

The Council and Commission discussed: 1) The importance of enhancing open space and greenbelts and establishing a trail system along the Arroyo Simi; 2) The need for a canine park and possible site locations; 3) The need for more youth oriented activities and a Teen Center; 4) Consideration for including a state-of-the-art kitchen with the Arroyo Vista Recreation Center expansion; 5) Moving forward with construction of the Veteran's Memorial; 6) Exploration of an additional ingress/egress for Arroyo Vista Community Park; 7) Consideration of an aquatic facility in Arroyo Vista Community Park; and 8) Adding security lighting or closing some of the parks at dusk.
